School Description

Finn Hill emphasizes a whole-child approach to education, emphasizing each student's social, emotional, and academic success. Our school supports social-emotional learning through a twice-weekly advisory period (Falcon Time). Students build character, relationships, and school spirit through our House System. Behavior supports are established and reinforced through our Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) system, Falcon P.R.I.D.E. Students are supported academically through our twice weekly intervention program, Falcon Flex, which allows students to participate in reteaching, challenge/enrichment activities, and general academic support. We promote family participation through Skyward, our web-based online grading and reporting system, PowerSchool Learning (to find teachers' websites) and FHMS/PTSA-hosted education nights on various issues ranging from tracking grades to Internet safety.


- Grades 6-8 English Language Arts (ELA): 78% of students at standard


2021-22 District Expenditures

Where does the money go?




State Assessment Results
